수업개요 및 목표

수업개요	Assuming that students took an introductory sociology course, this course will emphasize how to apply sociological concepts and theories to better understand Korean society. This course will also use film, drama, TV shows, documentaries, journal articles, books, reports, and newspapers as a way of approaching social problems. By introducing diverse social issues and problems, this course aims to help students think and discuss many aspects of Korean society in English. Two instructors, Prof. Hee-Je Bak and Prof. Gowoon Jung will co-teach this course. The first half before the mid-term exam will be lectured by Prof. Bak and the latter half will be lectured by Prof. Jung. All the lectures are pre-recorded and uploaded on e-campus.
수업목표	This course aims to enhance students' understanding of Korean society through sociological perspectives. Over the last five decades, Korea has undergone rapid economic, social, and cultural changes, including rapid economic growth in the 1970s and 1980s and the recent development of information technology and the entertainment industry in the 2000s. In a climate where tradition and modernity intermingle, this course will aim to advance our understanding of Korean culture, economy, politics, gender, family, religion, and media in a complex way. Throughout the semester, we will discuss diverse topics which represent contemporary Korean society, from Confucianism, economic inequality, Hallyu(Korean waves), consumption culture, migration and multiculturalism and so forth. We will discuss broad issues which characterize contemporary Korean society, instead of focusing on a narrow topic in depth.

수업유형 추가설명	1) Attendance (10%) - Please note that class attendance is important in this course. Students are expected to take pre-recorded lectures every week. All the lectures are pre-recorded and uploaded on the e-campus. Each recorded lecture has a specific due date. For your attendance to be counted, you should watch it before the due date. Your activities on the e-campus will be automatically logged and counted for the attendance. - Two absences(or lates) will be allowed without any penalty. - Since you can move around classes for the first week, the due data for the first week's lecture is extended to the second week (15th of March). 2) Class Participation (Submission of Study Journals) (20%) - Students should submit Study Journals (Summaries of the recorded lectures) in the designated dates. - For the journal, you should give your own summary of lectures in English. We expect a page of summary per each week's topic with 200-300 words. Each journal should be submitted in the 4th, 7th, 12th, and 15th week. That is, the first study journal should include your summary of lectures for Week 1 – Week 4 (four pages long in total), the second for Week 5- Week 7(3 pages long in total), and so forth. - Submitted study journals will be graded on an individual basis according to the following principles. 5 points: Most of the lecture summary is made in your own words without copying slides, and the deadline is met. 3 points: The lecture summary is submitted on time, but more than half of the summary is basically a copy-paste of lecture slides. 1 point: Although you submit a study journal on time, it is so poor to call it a lecture summary. (eg. The summary is far away from the lecture content of the week or not made in complete sentences. Or the words count less than 200.) 0 point: The study journal is submitted late for any reason or no submission. - It is completely your responsibility to meet the deadline. We strongly recommend you to submit the journal a couple of days before the deadline for the case of unexpected technical troubles. - Additionally, we ask you to submit a journal to evaluate your activities in the class at the end of semester. The final (5th) journal to evaluate your activities and experiences with Tutors in the class (Teacher-Student Interaction Facilitation program) will be checked on only whether you submit it on time (2 points) or not (0 point). - Questions related to the assignment should be directed to your tutor. Tutors will give an answer to the questions raised by the submitted journals, after categorizing them. The answers will be posted on the Q&A Board, so that all the students can read them. 3) Mid-term (35%) and Final Exam (35%) There will be two exams on the e-campus. The exam may consist of multiple-choice questions. The exams will be taken with an open book policy and they will cover the readings, lectures, and other materials discussed in the class. The online exams which will be monitored via zoom will be held on April 24 and June 19 (6:10pm-7:00pm). We cannot change the exam dates and hours. You should make sure to be available on the exam dates and hours. If you are not certain, please do not take this course this semester. While taking the exam, you should turn video and mic on,
