Short course description:	The course provides students with the upper-intermediate (B2) level of English lexis, grammar, orthography, phonetics and phonology. Based on communicative and competency-based approaches, the course aims to teach students both oral and written academic English and develop autonomous learning and cross-cultural communicative skills. Students improve their phonological, orthographical, grammatical and lexical competencies and develop speaking, listening, writing and reading skills of the upper-intermediate level of academic English. The form of studies includes lectures, seminars, self-study tasks and work in SANAKO lab and in virtual Moodle environment.
Course content:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.Modal verbs and words with modal meaning; 2.Definite, indefinite and zero articles; 3.Subordinate clauses, punctuation; 4.Conditionals and wish-clauses; 5.Passive voice; 6.Impersonal forms of verbs (infinitive and gerund); 7.Techniques of listening, reading, summarizing and creating an academic text; 8.Methods of organizing an academic text; 9.Communication and public speaking; 10. Transport and transport-related issues; 11. Architecture; 12. Globalization; 13.Psychology and personality types; 14.Information technology; innovation and their applicability in various areas of life; 15. Participating in academic discussions, giving an academic opinion; 16. Planning and writing; paraphrasing, citing and compiling a bibliography; 17.Analyzing and conveying scientific information.
