## Teaching Schedule

Week/Date	Course Content/Supporting Materials
Week 1	Course Introduction: Overview of course objectives and expectations.
Week 2	Thai Pronunciation and Listening Practice: Focus on pronunciation of Thai consonants, vowels, and tones, using games and multimedia.
Week 3	Thai Pronunciation and Listening Practice (Continued): Further exercises in pronunciation, with emphasis on accuracy and fluency.
Week 4	Basic Greetings and Conversations: Role-play scenarios such as restaurants and hotels, focusing on basic communication skills.
Week 5	Basic Greetings and Conversations (Continued): Practice in different contexts, enhancing conversational abilities.
Week 6	Listening for Key Information: Activities include listening to news and conversations, with an emphasis on summarization skills.
Week 7	Listening for Key Information (Continued): Further practice in listening and summarizing, using more complex materials.
Week 8	Expressing Opinions in Thai: Group discussions and exercises focused on articulating opinions and ideas clearly.
Week 9	Expressing Opinions in Thai (Continued): Advanced exercises in expressing opinions, with peer feedback and refinement.
Week 10	Expressing Opinions in Thai (Continued): Continued focus on developing the ability to articulate thoughts and opinions clearly, based on the progress made in previous sessions.
Week 11	Listening and Speaking in Business Contexts: Simulation of business meetings and presentations, emphasizing formal communication techniques and project-based learning.
Week 12	Listening and Speaking in Business Contexts (Continued): Continued practice in business communication, with group activities and multimedia support (e.g., videos, slides).
Week 13	Storytelling and Public Speaking: Practice

	in delivering Thai folk tales and short speeches using storytelling techniques.
Week 14	Storytelling and Public Speaking (Continued): Peer coaching and additional practice in public speaking, with feedback on performance.
Week 15	Academic Listening and Speaking: Listening to short academic lectures and engaging in discussions using the Flipped Classroom approach. Evaluation through comprehension tests and summary presentations.
Week 16	Final Review and Examination: Comprehensive review of all course content through games and group activities, followed by oral and written exams.
